In honor of the tragedy that struck American soil ten years ago 106.9, a local radio station, held a memorial ceremony at the Tulsa fair grounds. 911 balloons were blown up with a glow stick attached and released at 9:11 p.m.. Drawing a crowd of hundreds and Fox 23 news, this was a touching and creative way to remember the robbed lives of over 3,000 years ago. Key Club was asked to help with setting up before hand. Working for almost three hours, many of the officers helped blow up the 911 balloons. Shortly before 9:11, the balloons were passed out to the public. After an emotional opening ceremony and a moment of silence, the 911 balloons were released into the night sky.
